



## Before you import


Before you import into <u>Google My Maps</u>, you will need your map data as a KML file with icon labels. You can find detailed <u>instructions</u> in this document.

[exclamation icon?] Make sure you select **KML file with icon labels** while exporting your map data







## Set Default View



Search for your location and adjust the zoom level using the icons on the bottom right corner



Click on the three vertical dots ( i ) next to your map name and select "Set default view"




Once the file is uploaded, the layer will refresh with all the icons from your KML file. You have now successfully imported your Green Map data into Google My Maps.


## Add images




Select one of the sites on Open Green Map



Right click (or control click on Mac) on the photo and copy the image address.




Then, click the site on My Map, and the camera icon on lower right.



Add the URL there. Save by clicking Select.

You can chose another image in the same manner if you prefer

Consider adding related icons directly to the image using https://www.befunky.com/ or other photo editing software.



Your image is on your MyMap.

CAUTION: when you want to delete an image, click the Pencil to edit, then use the Trash Can in the black band <u>directly below</u> the image. If you use the Trash Can next to the Camera, you will delete the site permanently!
