## Old Town

Located from Division Street north to Armitage Avenue and east from Lasalle Street to Sheffield Avenue.

It was settled in the mid nineteenth century by an influx of German farmers and semi-skilled laborers who left Germany seeking prosperity. During the 1960s, Old Town became a center of a Bohemian renaissance movement. In recent years, upscale retail, dining establishments, and town homes have blanketed the area. The annual Old Town art fair is one of the largest in the country. Old Town remains one of the most lively and picturesque neighborhoods in Chicago.

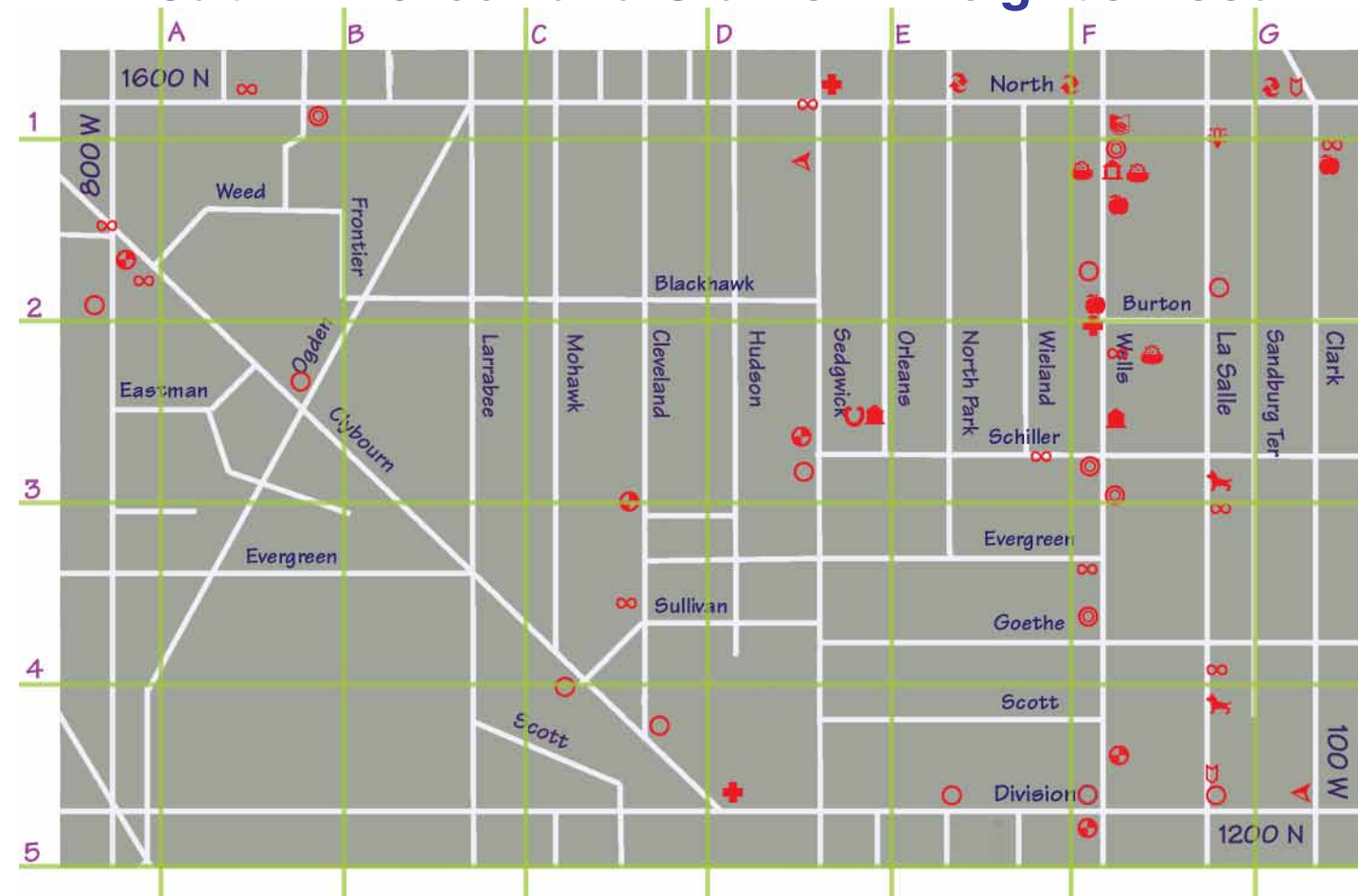
